Adapt the plan to any type of emergency and to the requirements each one has, children, the elderly, persons with different needs, and include your pets

Follow these 4 stage:

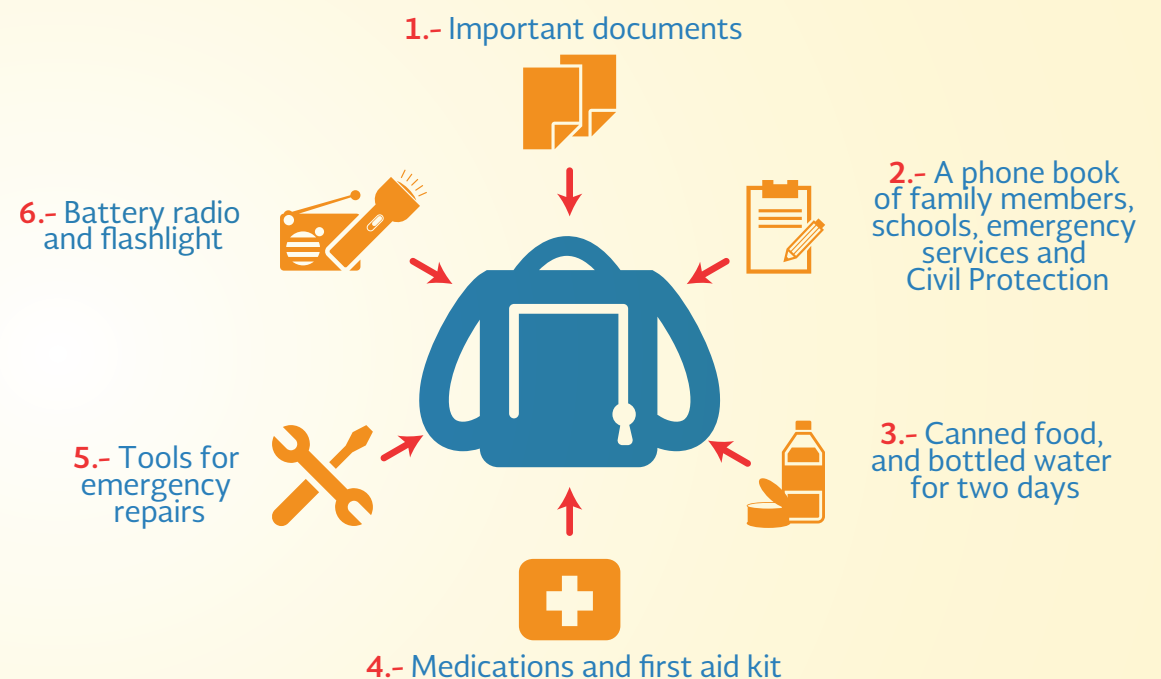


During emergencies, have you considered... what is more secure, inside or outside my home?

- ▶ There is no general rule, because results I bases on the type of risk and the characteristics your home has
- ▶ Keep calm, do not run, do not scream, do not push
- ▶ Proceed to the meeting point previously agreed on with family members

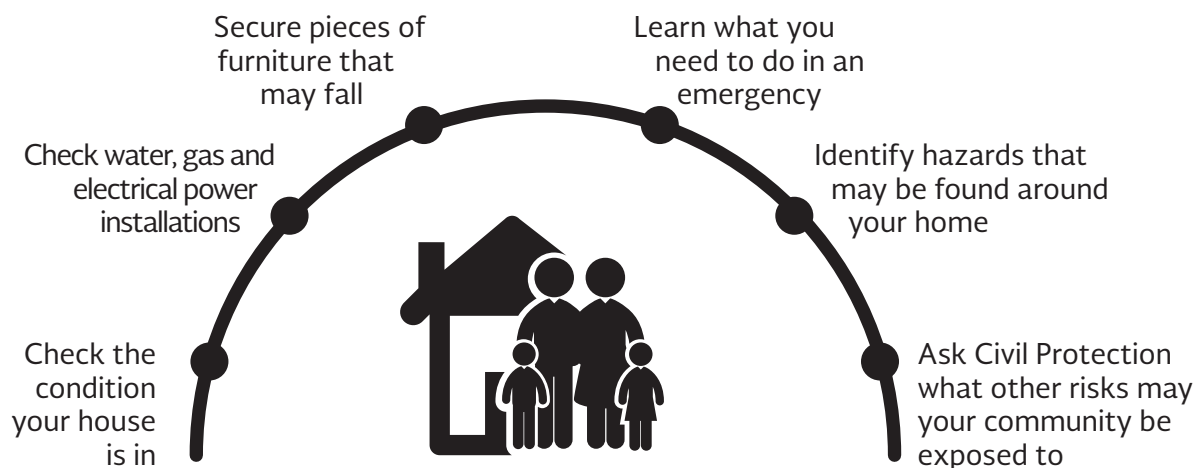


Prepare your family plan

So you can reduce risks and act in an organized and coordinated manner in case of emergencies

Follow the next...

Identify risks:



With your family, decide which is the meeting point outside your home; a park, or with a family member



Entrust a friend, neighbor, or family member with a duplicate of house keys and important documents

If you have pets:



Include them in your family plan



Anticipate your pet's needs, and how to solve them in case of an emergency



Make sure they wear a collar with a tag having name, address, and telephone number



Never leave them tied, or outside the home

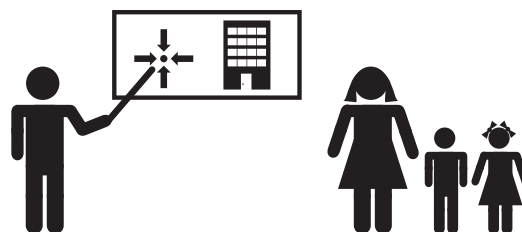


Keep them on a leash, and muzzle if necessary

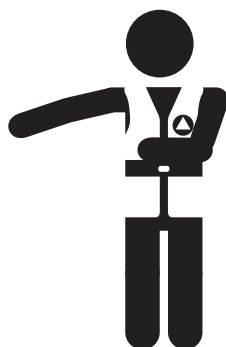
When authorities ask you to evacuate your home, do so; this is for your safety and security



Rehearse evacuation drills. Test your own civil protection knowledge and culture



In case of a disaster, you must obey indications given by authorities



Locate the temporary shelter you will go to, and carry only what is necessary
